2. Show the film (tech tips below)

Home viewings

- Invite your friends over for a Sell-Off party
- Encourage each of them to take the Sell-Off pledge to show it to 10 of their friends
- What can we do? Share ideas with friends and on www.facebook.com/selloffnhs if you want to take action as a result of watching the film

Public screenings

- Find a venue anywhere that has a screen and some chairs
 - Try arts cinemas, community centres, colleges, schools, pubs, social clubs, training centres, lidos, sports centres, town halls
 - o Some organisations might offer the space for free
 - o If you need to pay ask for a local/community discount
 - Take a collection to cover the screening costs a donation to the film production

- Ask if you can have the space regularly eg first Monday of the month this
 helps more people attend and may get media attention
- Invite people, put up flyers locally, publicise in local media, blogs etc
 - o Allow four weeks from starting to publicise til the event date
 - Tell us about your event: we'll create an event on <u>facebook.com/selloffnhs</u> to publicise it

TECH TIPS

View it on YouTube

The YouTube video has even greater impact if seen on a big screen – here's how you can do it:

a. On a Smart TV – if you've got one, you probably know how to access the internet on it!

b. On a normal TV – connect your computer to the TV

Display your computer screen on your TV using HDMI port

Check your computer has an HDMI port first. It looks like this: -

Find an HDMI cable



Connect HDMI port on computer to the HDMI 1 or HDMI 2 port on your TV, using the cable Using your TV remote, select the source/input as HDMI 1 or 2

This will display your computer screen on the TV, so just open up http://youtu.be/ultKvnw2h3Q on your computer and play video
